Selective mapping. A technology for efficiently levying the land

Taxing land is one of the most efficient and least inflationary ways for governments to raise revenue. So why don't they raise more money from land property? Part of the explanation is that many governments lack the maps and cadastral information to exploit these taxes. CartoData has developed the concept of selective mapping, based on change detection technologies. Selective mapping allows governments for periodically and continuously monitor land use, without going into extensive tax mapping programs.
