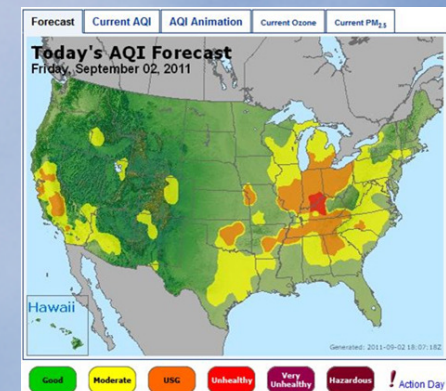
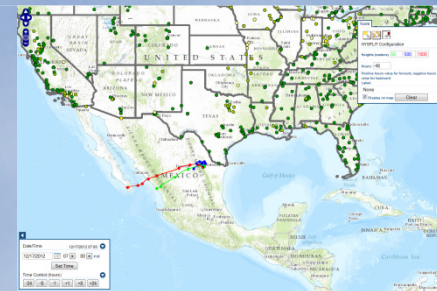
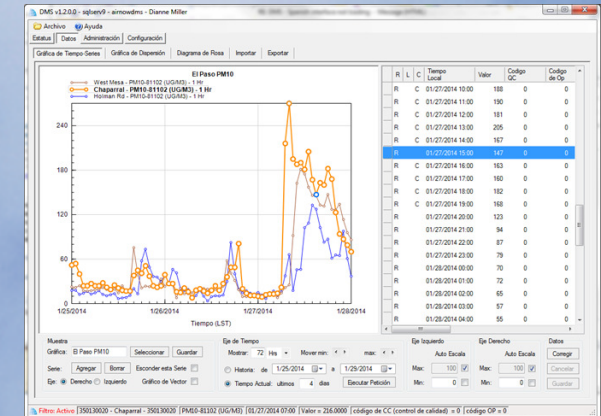
AirNow-International System:
